



NOTICE AFFORDING THE OPPORTUNITY FOR A PUBLIC HEARING

Parker County in conjunction with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to reconstruct FM 1187 in the City of Aledo, Parker County, Texas. The limits of the project are from Oak Street to IH-20; a total distance of approximately 2.1 miles.

The existing roadway consists of two 12-foot lanes, four-foot shoulders, and open drainage ditches. The usual right-of-way (ROW) width is 100 feet.

The proposed reconstruction would provide a four lane divided roadway with grassy median, curb and gutter, and sub-surface drainage improvements. Outside travel lanes would be 14 feet wide, inside lanes would be 11 feet wide. Six-foot sidewalks would be constructed on both sides of the roadway for the length of the project. The typical right-of-way width varies from 80 feet to a maximum of 115 feet. The proposed improvements would require the acquisition of approximately 0.2 acre of new right-of-way, 0.8 acre of permanent drainage easements, and 8.9 acres of temporary construction easements by Parker County. No relocations or displacements are associated with the proposed project.

Impacts to one jurisdictional water of the U.S. would total approximately 0.07 acre. The proposed project would not encroach on floodplains or wetlands.

Any interested citizen may request a public hearing covering the social, economic and environmental effects of the proposed location and design for this project. Requests for a public hearing must be submitted in writing on or before February 28, 2012, to Mrs. Maribel P. Chavez, P.E., TxDOT Fort Worth District Engineer, 2501 SW Loop 820, Fort Worth, Texas 76133. If such a request is received, a public hearing will be scheduled. Adequate notice will be published to announce the date and location of the hearing.
