

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

FM 3391 (East Renfro Street) from IH 35W to East of CR 602

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct an open house public meeting to discuss improvements to FM 3391 (East Renfro Street) in Burleson (Johnson County). The meeting is scheduled for Thursday, October 28th, 2010 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. at the Stribling Elementary (Cafeteria) located at 1881 E. Renfro Street in Burleson, Texas.

This proposed project would begin at the intersection of FM 3391 and IH 35W in Burleson and end at the intersection of FM 3391 and CR 602. The proposed project would widen the existing three-lane undivided to six lanes of divided roadway between IH 35W and S. Hurst Road and to four lanes of divided roadway between S. Hurst Road and CR 602. Dedicated right-turn and left-turn lanes would also be added as needed. The proposed project includes widening the existing right-of-way section that varies from 120 feet - 140 feet to a proposed 120 feet – 220 feet.

The purpose of this meeting is to provide a forum for exchange of information to help create a balanced design. Maps, drawings, and other information about the project will be on display. Members of the project team will be available to answer questions during the meeting. No formal presentation will be provided.

All interested citizens are invited to attend this meeting to view the displays and provide the project team with comments. Written comments may be presented either at the meeting or may be mailed to TxDOT so they may be incorporated in the public meeting record. Written comments may be submitted to:
