Notice of Public Meeting

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed upgrade of FM 2105 from US 87 to US 277 in San Angelo, Texas. The meeting will be held on Monday August 13, 2018, at the Northridge Baptist Church Fellowship Hall, 2447 W. FM 2105, San Angelo, Texas, 76901. The meeting will be held in an open house format from 6:00 PM to 7:30 PM, with a presentation at 6:30 PM.

The purpose of the public meeting is to present the proposed project and receive comments. With this project, TxDOT seeks to reduce congestion and enhance safety on FM 2105. For this project, TxDOT proposes to reconstruct the existing roadway and potentially construct center and right turn lanes where appropriate. The proposed improvements will take place within existing TxDOT right of way. TxDOT San Angelo District is specifically seeking local information to better understand the appropriate locations for turn lanes, existing drainage problems, and traffic control strategies. Maps showing the proposed project location and geometric design will be available for viewing at the meeting. This information will also be available for public inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM at the TxDOT San Angelo District Office located at 4502 Knickerbocker Rd., San Angelo, TX 76901.

All interested citizens are invited to attend this public meeting. Written comments may be submitted either in person or by mail to the TxDOT District Office, Ms. Becki Perkins, Environmental Specialist, 4502 Knickerbocker Rd., San Angelo, TX 76901. Written comments must be received by August 28, 2018 to be included in the Public Meeting Summary.
